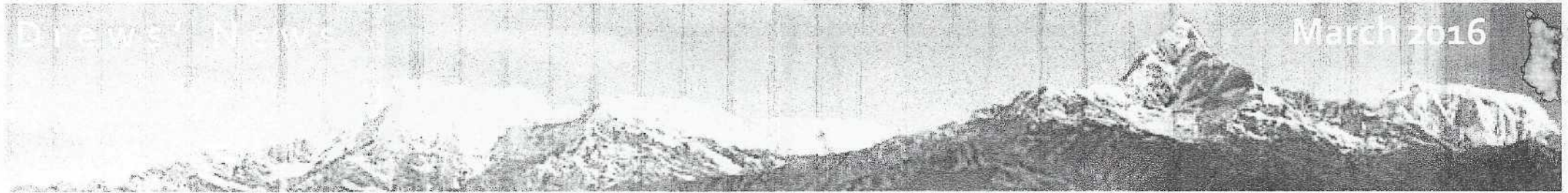


Update from the Drews family in Nepal (MARCH 2016)

Please pray that the church would continue to grow in a healthy way and for leaders for the next generation.

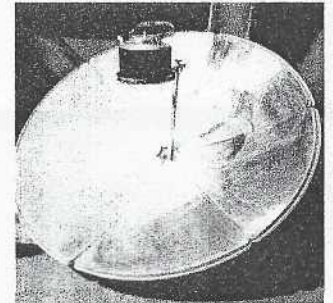
